A DAY TRIP TO THE TRANSFĂGĂRAȘAN ROAD TO SEE NATURE AND BEARS



The Transfăgărășan Road – The Beautiful Road in Romania
Transfăgărășan is considered one of the most beautiful mountain roads in the world and is located in the heart of the Southern Carpathian Mountains. The road climbs to an altitude of over 2,000 meters, crosses the Pagarrush Ridge and offers:

Dramatic twists and turns

Breathtaking panoramic views / natural waterfalls / spectacular shooting points

If you are looking for must-see attractions in Romania or a nature trip in the Carpathian Mountains, this is the most impressive route.

Vidraro Dam and Lake Vidraro

During the hike we will stop at Lacul și Barajul Vidraru – a huge dam about 166 meters high, which forms Lake Vidraru.

What awaits you in the place?

An impressive view of the turquoise lake / one of the most beautiful photo spots in the Carpathians

Lake Bala Lak – The Pearl of the Carpathians

We will continue to Bâlea Lac – a glacial lake at an altitude of 2,034 meters above sea level.

You can enjoy a light walk around the lake / coffee in front of an alpine view / clear mountain air / spectacular photos

The Transfagaschen region is known as one of the regions with a high concentration of brown bears in Europe.

During the trip, there is an option to spot bears in Romania from the car and in safe spots only.

A daily boat trip of about 5 hours in the Danube Delta, one of the most special biological regions in Europe. The delta is a network of channels, lakes and swamps, most of which is a natural area that provides habitat for dozens of species of birds and rare animals. During the cruise, you can be impressed by the wild nature, see ducks, herons, pelicans and other rare waterfowl species, and experience the amazing silence of the Danube.

The trip includes a stop at an authentic fishing village, where you can enjoy a traditional lunch with fresh fish dishes from the Danube. The experience combines the local culture with the authentic atmosphere of the Romanian villages.

A fairytale day trip to the Carpathian Mountains – the Bulbotz and the Fleş Palace

A spectacular day trip from Bucharest to the heart of the Carpathian Mountains, combining wild nature, breathtaking views and a visit to one of the most beautiful palaces in Europe.

We will ascend to the Bucegi Mountains Nature Reserve, an impressive mountainous region that rises to an altitude of over 2,000 meters and offers spectacular alpine views of forests, cliffs and green valleys.

On the mountain plateau we will visit the famous natural phenomenon Babele – special rocks in the form of huge mushrooms that were formed over thousands of years by wind and snow. Next to them is the famous Sphinx of Bucegi rock, which resembles a human face in shape and arouses curiosity and local legends.

After visiting the mountains we will descend to the beautiful resort town of Sinaia, known as the "Pearl of the Carpathians". Here we will visit the famous royal palace Peleş Castle – a magnificent palace from the 19th century that served as the summer palace of the kings of Romania and is considered one of the most impressive palaces in Europe thanks to its special architecture, magnificent halls and well-kept gardens around it.

The trip combines spectacular nature, alpine landscapes and royal history – a perfect experience for visitors to Romania.

A day trip to the historic city of Sibiu is a journey to one of the most beautiful and well-preserved cities in the Transylvanian region. The city was founded more than 800 years ago by German (Saxon) settlers and was an important cultural and commercial center for centuries.

The old city of Sibiu is considered one of the most impressive cities in Europe, with cobbled streets, colorful houses, spectacular squares and a special atmosphere that takes visitors back centuries.

Piața Mare.

It is the largest and most impressive square in the city and is home to spectacular historical buildings, cafes, restaurants and museums. Many festivals and events are held here throughout the year.

Next to the big square is the small square

Piața Mică.

The area is full of picturesque alleys, small shops, art galleries and ancient buildings from the Middle Ages. This is one of my favorite places for a relaxing walk and photography.

The Bridge of Liars – The Famous Story of the City

One of Sibiu's most well-known symbols is

The Bridge of Lies.

The bridge was built in the 19th century and is the first bridge in Romania to be built of cast iron. According to local legend, the bridge "knows" when someone lies – and that's why it got its famous name.

Evangelical Cathedral

The high Gothic cathedral was built in the 14th century and is one of the city's most prominent symbols. The tower offers spectacular views of the rooftops of the Old Town and the surrounding Carpathian Mountains.
